RESOLUTION NO. 2019-Q

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING TRESPASSING IN TOWNSHIP-OWNED
STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FACILITIES AND BEST MANAGEMENT
PRACTICES**

WHEREAS, Conewago Township owns, operates and maintains various stormwater management facilities and best management practices, throughout the Township, including but not limited to : Allwood Manor, Murren Manor, Indian Ridge, Sherry Village, Conewago Estates and facilities at Amp, Cougar, Knisley, Blettner, Sycamore and Conewago; and

WHEREAS, the Township-owned stormwater management facilities and best management practices are increasingly being accessed and used as public recreation areas; and

WHEREAS, these facilities and best management practices pose risks to the public as they are designed to collect and convey stormwater, to periodically flood, and to capture and hold various contaminants contained in stormwater; and

WHEREAS, the access and use of the public at these facilities and best management practices could jeopardize the intended operation and function; and

WHEREAS, the Township-owned stormwater retention/detention ponds are not specifically designed for public access or use as recreation areas and are not maintained or intended by the Township as such.

NOW THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Conewago Township as follows:

1. The Township shall prohibit trespassing in all Township owned stormwater management facilities and best management practices.
2. Conewago Township Officials are hereby authorized to post no trespassing as required by law.
