RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CONEWAGO TOWNSHIP,
ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE CONEWAGO POLICE
DEPARTMENT'S GUIDELINES FOR THE OPERATION AND UTILIZATION OF
MOBILE VIDEO RECORDER (MVR) DEVICES**

WHEREAS, Conewago Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, (the "Township") is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the "Commonwealth"); and

WHEREAS, the Township has adopted a Personnel Manual through the adoption of a series of Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2014-R, as contained in the Personnel Manual, governs the Chief of Police of Conewago Township and the promulgation of Police Department Policy ("Departmental Policy"); and

WHEREAS, in general, Resolution No. 2014-R, requires all Departmental Policy to be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has proposed a Departmental Policy on the operation and utilization of Mobile Video Recorder (MVR) devices installed in the Conewago Township Police Department patrol vehicles, which Departmental Policy is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wish to approve the aforesaid Departmental Policy.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Conewago Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1. The Departmental Policy on the operation and utilization of Mobile Video Recorder (MVR) devices installed in the Conewago Township Police Department patrol vehicles, which Departmental Policy attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. If any word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion of this Resolution or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, then such word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion, or the proscribed application thereof, shall be severable and the remaining provisions of this resolution and all applications thereof, not having been declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
