**RESOLUTION NO. 2021- Z**

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**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CONEWAGO TOWNSHIP,  
ADAMS COUNTY, STATING THE BOARD'S INTENT TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF  
THE EXISTING PRIVATE HYDRANT LOCATED AT 210 BLETTNER AVENUE AND,  
UPON ACCEPTANCE THEREOF, TO ASSUME THE OBLIGATION TO PAY WATER  
CHARGES LEVIED BY THE BOROUGH OF HANOVER FOR HYDRANTS  
PURSUANT TO ITS RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS TARIFF**

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**WHEREAS**, a standard private fire hydrant (the "Hydrant") presently exists on the property at 210 Blettner Avenue, Conewago Township, Adams County (the "Property"), which Hydrant was originally installed and maintained at the request and at the cost of the Property owner; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hydrant is served by the Borough of Hanover's Water System and the Property owner pays to the Borough of Hanover a charge in accordance with Hanover Borough's Schedule of Fire Service Rates pursuant to its tariff approved by the Public Utility Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Property owner desires to terminate service to the Hydrant and permanently remove the same; and

**WHEREAS**, upon consultation with the Borough of Hanover, the Township has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township and its residents to assume ownership of the Hydrant and thereafter to pay rates to the Borough of Hanover in accordance with the Borough's Commission approved tariff.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Conewago Township, Adams County, as follows:

1. The Township hereby confirms its intent to assume ownership over the Hydrant in exchange for consideration to be paid to the Property owner in an amount not to exceed \$1.00 and subject to delivery of all required rights of access for purposes of owning, operating, and maintaining the Hydrant; and


2. The Township hereby also confirms its intent, upon assuming ownership over the Hydrant, to assume the obligation to pay to the Borough of Hanover rates for a standard public fire hydrant as established by the Borough from time-to-time in its Commission approved tariff; and


3. The Township hereby authorizes and directs its appropriate officers, employees, and representatives to do all things necessary to accomplish the same.
