RESOLUTION NO. 2021-AA

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CONEWAGO TOWNSHIP,
ADAMS COUNTY, TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING THE IMPOSITION AND
COLLECTION OF STORMWATER FEES IN THE TOWNSHIP, EFFECTIVE
JANUARY 1, 2022**

WHEREAS, the Conewago Township (“Township”) Board of Supervisors (“Board”) previously adopted a stormwater management fee ordinance, establishing Article VI “Stormwater Management Fee” of the Conewago Township Code (“Code”), which imposes stormwater management fees upon properties in the Township subject to certain collection procedures specified therein; and

WHEREAS, Section 76-48 of the Code allows the Board to promulgate policies and procedures relating to the interpretation, enforcement, and applications of the provisions of stormwater management; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interests of the health, safety, and general wellness of Township residents to promulgate the following policies related to stormwater management.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Conewago Township, Adams County, as follows:

Section 1: Directives

1. The Township hereby temporarily suspends the imposition and collection of stormwater fees in the Township as set forth in Part II, “General Legislation,” Article VI “Stormwater Management Fee,” of the Conewago Township Code.

Section 2: Effective Date

2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as of January 1, 2022.


Section 3: Sunset Provision

3. This Resolution shall automatically extinguish on December 31, 2022. Beginning January 1, 2023, the imposition and collection of stormwater fees pursuant to Article VI of the Township Code shall be fully reinstated.
