A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CONEWAGO TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE NAMING OF EISENHOWER DRIVE

WHEREAS, Conewago Township ("Township") is a Pennsylvania township of the second class, organized and existing pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 65101, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, 53 P.S. § 67329 empower the Township Board of Supervisors ("Board") to provide for and regulate the naming of streets, roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, a safety issue has been brought to the attention of the Board due to two properties sharing the address of 100 Eisenhower Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it to be in the Township's best interests of health, safety, and general welfare, to resolve this issue by renaming a portion of Eisenhower Drive to West Eisenhower Drive.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Conewago Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The above recitals are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. <u>Adoptions</u>. The Board hereby renames the portion of Eisenhower Drive beginning at the intersection of High Street and Eisenhower Drive that runs to the eastern boundary of the Township shared with Penn Township. Township officials shall notify the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in the event signage needs to be updated.

SECTION 3. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. <u>Repealer</u>. All resolutions, or parts thereof, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, shall be hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
